


I know Lincs LRC members helped with the running for many of the events which contributed to their success as well as acting as organisers for the Comp Safari.

MARSHAL AND OFFICIAL INCENTIVE 2025

Marshals and officials at any event are essential for events to run, these roles range from the coffee on the day, the scrutineers, the time keepers, marshals and signing on processes. Without anyone taking on these roles events just cannot run. To encourage members to assist with these roles the committee has devised an incentive scheme starting from the first event of the year running until the last event of the year. The scheme will reward members with a free membership for the following year, so a saving currently of £25. To be part of the incentive the member must be an official at a minimum 6 competitive events in 2025.



After a successful year last year, we are aiming to repeat this unique trialling experience. Sections will run on the Saturday afternoon and continue on the Sunday. The Saturday will consist of a couple of warm up sections, followed by a break to ensure it gets dark and a further 10 sections. with up to 10 sections on the Sunday.

Rules:

These night rules are in addition to the normal CCV rules specified in the ALRC yearbook

- 1) All drivers must supply their own torch for walking the course.
- 2) A fluorescent jacket MUST be worn by all drivers, navigators and marshals whenever they are out of a vehicle.
- 3) Up to 6 forward facing lights may be fitted, all must be forward of the driver and fixed and not moveable by the driver or passenger while competing.
- 4) LED lights will count as 1 per 150mm (6") rounded up, so a 2 foot bar counts as 4 lamps.
- 5) Torches must be switched off and stored safely when driving.
- 6) All rear lights (4 max, 1 min) must be red and 21 watt.
- 7) Reversing lights can only be used when operated by a gearbox switch.

Times:

Saturday

Scrutineering 3 pm First section 4 pm Sunday 10am

If we have plenty of drivers we will just go straight through with no break, as hopefully it will be dark after 2/3 sections

Cost £40 for 2 days trialling or £30 for a one day entry, both days count towards the 2024 championship.

Marshals are required please - More the merrier to help with the darkness. I promise the sun will be shining this year. ☺☺

Camping will be available on the Saturday night. There is no water or facilities.

Club V'S Trophy 2025

With the re introduction of new club versus trophy against P&D in 2023, of which P&D won in 2023 and 2024. We need to up our games and take the trophy back off them.

The events included for 2025 are Wickenby Comp, Claxby CCV , RTV, Stainby Comp, Eckington RTV, CCV and Day Comp, Newton Lodge Comp, Brotherton CCV and the Malachi Comp. All events are included in both clubs championship, this is so all members of both clubs will be in attendance. Results are taken from the top 3 drivers from each club from the relevant disciplines. So both clubs can be rewarded points. Points will be rewarded from 10 to 5. Ie 1st 10, 2nd 9 3rd 8, 4th 7, 5th 6, 6th 5. The club with the most cumulative points at the end of the year takes home the trophy.

A flat county, but always a challenge

THE LINC'S three day has been held on this Mayday bank holiday weekend for the last 10 years writes Wayne Wells. Because of the usual loss of land story it has now moved to Manby Showground, not the best off-road site there is, but for a family weekend with camping it takes some beating.

Lincs have recently purchased a marquee, the hardest task of the weekend was erecting it for the first time. All that done, complete with special entrance and exit for height, the first motors rolled through for scrutineering.

Tony Summerfield was ably assisted by John Dominy and Mike Shaw in setting out 12 sections for the RTV which started at 10am on Saturday. Vince Manterfield in his 80" trialer that is taxed and tested dominated the event from start to finish. The event was open

and the big trophy to go for was the best overall scores from the whole weekend. Vince was obviously fancying his chances after this as CCVT driving is his usual discipline. Paul Smith drove well to finish second in his Series II with Jon Evison taking third in his 88" Tdi.

As well as the RTV the ladies trial used the same sections. For the last three years Sue Day has dominated this event but this year we had new drivers all being passengered by CCVT drivers, most of them with bags of experience and lots of courage. One driver who drove 300 miles to assist a lady was Rick Wells (no relation) the ex-Lincs secretary. His long journey from Scotland for the weekend was made worthwhile as Claire Dennis drove to victory. It was a just reward for Rick as Claire has navigated for him in many comps victories.

The RTV was won on two

points while at the other end of the scale 54 was the highest. The C of Cs had the right courses set for the ground and for the large variety of motors that entered.

Sunday saw a large entry for the CCVT. There were drivers from EMORC, Pennine and Peak and Dukeries as well as the Lincs Series One brigade, one surprise driver was Martin Cooper in his comp motor which he was saving for the National. John Dominy who has not driven for a while borrowed Vinc's motor, which incidentally was bought from him, and drove like he had never been away from the sport. He won overall in convincing style from Martin Cooper in his 88" cooler. In third place was Dave Rayson who was pleased to beat 14 standard 80" Land Rovers in his Series II.

Frank Champion was Clerk of Course assisted by Carl Davies,

who marked out in Series III Land Rovers. Wide gates with terrain catching the drivers out and not the pegs was the order of the day. The showery weather did not alter the clay based soil at Manby. The CCVT, enjoyed by all who drove it, proved you can make a man-made site challenging enough even for 'the best 4x4s by far'. Even though this was an open event the old faithful Solihull product proved that they still rule when it comes to off-roading.

Competitive safari is a different story. The buggies tend to dominate the scene in the UK. The buggy boys had to work hard to prove this statement at Manby. Only Mick Noquet in his Simmbugghini could match the quick Lincs trio of Spalding, Yates and Fielding in their ARC spec 3500cc coolers as Graham Stephenson reports:

Bank Holiday Monday saw the blue riband event of this popular open weekend. The comp attracted 30 entries and a good day's racing was anticipated with the morning sunshine.

The 2.4 mile course on this much-used Manby site was marked out by Wayne Wells assisted by John Dennis, both of whom are experienced off-roaders in all disciplines. The course was set out with large marker arrows as the drivers association recommends, the two flag system was in force, simply RED for stop and YELLOW for proceed with caution. Drivers also knew they would be penalised for any course deviations. Maximum time was set at 15 mins.

Also up for grabs was the Lincs donated team cup for the quickest team of three drivers, a cup that no-one seems to be able to take from Lincs. This

was the case again as Chris Spalding, Derek Yates and Dave Fielding finished in second, third and fifth respectively overall. Chris having no problems except for one embarrassing moment when his bonnet flew up 100 yards from the finish on run eight losing valuable time stopping to collect it then finding he had not fastened it down again.

First time out driver was Simon Boddy from the Northern Off-Road Club. Having defected from rallying, he decided to have a go at comp-safari and from the smile on his face he thoroughly enjoyed himself despite breaking a diff housing on run six.

The leaf sprung brigade had a good run at Manby the most impressive being Ben Knight in his 80" with his rebuilt engine, the runs he drove before he retired were fast, too fast for the rest of the motor. John Bihari

also had an enjoyable run out as did twice a year compere Adrian Beever's.

The privilege of having the only roll of the day went to David Faulks in his ex-Paul Clarke Bowler, fortunately without damage to man or machine. Pennine club member, Brent Taylor, in his Tdi powered coiler broke a turbo pipe which slowed his progress down significantly from run three. The wise drivers were getting their runs in early as the weather looked ominously like rain. The heavens opened at lunch time and continued for the rest of the day making all times much slower. 'Hey this is England' was heard several times as the drivers faced the wet conditions.

Bob Wilding (EMORC) was in with a chance of attaining a top three place when only 100 yards from the finish he grounded his Nissan powered Citroen based buggy on its hydro-pneumatic suspension, and was stuck for one minute, but as usual the Boston driver was happy with his result.

David James the Spalding based Lincs member blew his gearbox on run four putting him out for the day, but he will be out again at the next Bank Holiday in preparation for the Hillrally Championship where he is expected to be a front runner in the clubmans event.

The DLS sponsored buggy of Paul and Nick Teague was double driven with a mis-fire occurring on runs one and four. At the end of run six we saw flames billowing out of the rear of the motor which was caused by a broken oil pipe, with the on board fire extinguisher the fire

was quickly quelled and they completed the runs after minor repairs.

The third place went to Derek Yates who only had a stub axle to change all day. The winner, Mick Noquet in his 3.9i buggy, must like this ground as it was his second win in as many months. On his way to victory he was balked three times and blew an oil seal on a shocker.

Despite shearing a steering damper on run six Dave Fielding, the Bepler based Lincs member finished fifth. He must be the coolest driver around being so laid back he just enjoys himself whenever he competes.

NORC driver Derek Curtis had an expensive day With a leaking steering box, he just managed to finish his ten runs while using over five gallons of oil through his steering. Derek was one of many NORC members who thanked the host club for a good event.

The Heartbeat sponsored Warrior of Ken Cumberland ripped off a brake pipe on run three but it did not appear to slow down his progress, this was Ken's second weekend out in a row with this machine. One better than that was the Warrior that Robin Clarkson drove so well at Cornwall the day before, he then drove up North then back to Manby to enable Chris Marlow to compete in this comp in the Colibra turbo powered Warrior. At this level of the sport comp safaris are won in the garage, it is no coincidence that the top vehicles don't break down, it is simply good preparation.

Although he failed to finish the comp, Vince Manterfield won the overall trophy for his CCVT and RTV efforts.

Thanks went to TMS, Land Rover agents of Lincoln for sponsoring the event which ran like clockwork all weekend.



Our Code of Conduct

Please take your time to read and understand this

Use only rights of way with known, proven or provable vehicular rights. If challenged, discuss; if not resolved, then leave as requested until status is rechecked.

Keep to the defined track. Detour only to pass immovable obstructions. Report any obstructions (including low branches) to the highway authority and the local GLASS Area Representative. Be critical of your own abilities and equipment when assessing an obstruction; it is your right to abate a non-lawful obstruction, but do not commit yourself to a bigger task than you are equipped for.

If the route is not obvious on the ground, ask locally, or check on the maps held at the highway authority offices or consult the local GLASS Area Representative.

Travel at a quiet and unobtrusive pace and as slowly as practicable; we recommend a maximum of 12 mph when in a 4x4 and on an Unsurfaced Right of Way (URoW). Ensure your vehicle is fully road-legal, URoW are subject to the same laws as surfaced roads.

When travelling in groups keep to a small number, four or less in sensitive areas, in other areas up to six vehicles **MAY** be acceptable. Guidance should be sought from the relevant GLASS Area Representative. Weather and ground conditions should also be taken into account. On routes in good condition, split larger parties up and either use a different route or allow a good interval, at least 30 minutes, to elapse before following. With adverse weather and/or poor ground conditions avoid committing a second group to follow the same route.

Do not travel on URoW when they risk being affected beyond a point of natural recovery once the weather improves. If need be, walk some or the entire route first to determine its suitability. Do not use URoW that maybe damaged by the wheel pressure applied by your vehicle.

Avoid damage to trees, hedgerows and boundaries. Some roads carry vehicular rights but are physically too narrow for 4x4s.

Do not practice recovery techniques on any URoW. Use a winch only with extreme caution, and use only the correct equipment and techniques.

Be courteous to other road users - pull over and stop your vehicle for walkers, but pull over, stop your vehicle and switch off the engine for passing horses. Thank those who move over for you.

After consultations with Country Landowners Association and National Farmers Union HQ's, **"best practice"** dictates that gates if they were found to be secured in an open position should be left open and those which are found shut or swinging should be shut behind you; the landowner might appreciate being told about a gate insecurely propped open if you see them.

Keep dogs and children under supervision. Watch out for injured or trapped animals, and report all suspicious events to the landholder.

Guard against all risks of fire. Take your litter home and that left by others if you see it, wherever practicable. Plastic bags can suffocate livestock if swallowed.

Help to keep all water clean. Remember that wildlife faces many threats and URoW are valuable habitats, take special care in spring and early summer. **Follow the Country Code**, it is for your guidance only.

Be considerate of group sizes at meeting points or food stops.
